### Alfalfa For Dairy Cows.

A summary of feeding trials by the Wisconsin station with dairy cows shows that alfalfa can be made to take the place of at least one-half of the grain usually fed our dairy cows, and as the nutrients needed by dairy cows can be produced much more cheaply with alfalfa than with grain the cost of producing milk may be greatly reduced by its use.
