## PROMINENT STOCK MAN GIVES ADVICE

Says Horses, Mules, Dairying, Orchards, All Thrive Here

Lewis Gerber, the Klamath stockman, well known in Lakeview is now at Porterville, Calif., on a visit. In writing to the Bonanza Bulletin what he says of Klamath county will apply equally to Lake county: I cannot close without a few words in regard to the raising of good horses and mules. Klamath county stockmen should not be afraid of crowding the market with good stock. The market is good and will continue so. Recently mules sold here at \$350 and \$450 a span. Horses weighing from 1200 to 1550 pounds sold at prices ranging from \$175 to \$225 a head.

Orchard lands are selling for fabulous sums. Many people are coming here from the east, but as they are unable to buy, they will go elsewhere, and I am putting forth efforts to send some of the best of them to our glorious Klamath county.

## Sure, but Expensive Potato Bug Exterminator

During the recent meeting of the farmer's institute held at Deu Drope, Idaho, Zanontello Baker exhibited his most recent invention, a device which is a sure means of eradicating the potato bug. It is estimated that the potato bug costs the farmers of this country more than \$10,000,000 a year. This vast sum can be saved, Mr. Baker argues, by the use of his appliance.

"To be effective such an appliance must be simple," said Mr. Baker. "I have given much study of the habits of the potato bug, and I find that he can be lured where he cannot be coerced. This is the foundation of my plan; I lure 'em."

"First, I set up a pile driver in a field. Then I bring up a traction engine. This, as you may readily understand, is to furnish the pile driver with motive force.

"I then place a street piano in the rear of the pile driver and connect it also with the traction engine with a light driving belt. A small dynamo furnishes the current for a battery of six arc lamps, is established.

"When all is ready, on some dark night during the dark of the moon the mechanism is started. The street piano sends forth its sweet strains, which lure the potato bugs toward the light. They walk under the pile driver and are crushed to death."
