## MINES AND MINING

Supt. E. O. Kelly, of the Goldberg Butte Mining Company was in town last Friday and Saturday, buying supplies for the mine. Work is being pushed with shifts day and night.

A vein of good milling ore was cut last Thursday in the tunnel. One crew of workmen are drifting in the vein and another crew are pushing the tunnel ahead to cut the next vein.

The force on the Jumbo Chief mining property has been increased and development is being pushed as fast as possible. The owners are elated over the showing and are making preparations to do extensive development work.

A company of California capitalists have taken an option on a group of claims joining the Jumbo and will start work as soon as supplies can be hauled to the camp.

F. J. Reilly, secretary and treasurer for the Jumbo Chief Mining Company of Goldberg, Oregon, states that he has received a small amount of samples of ore from the Jumbo Chief and the Goldberg Butte claims and he is willing to convince any one that this rock is full of gold and he says he will pan the gold for any one that so wishes and will call at his present office in the Colorado Hotel. It is a convincing argument when one can see the solid rock pounded and the pure gold panned from it, but Mr. Reilly knows there are a good many in town and he is willing to show them.

Several owners are preparing to start work and before fall Windy Hollow or as it is now called Goldberg will be a bustling mining camp.
