plained in his letter to you, we found nothing on examining the stomachs which you inclosed, that would give a clue to the poisoning, as the only abnormal condition noted was a blackening of the inner coating of the stomach, which probably was a post mortem condition. From your description of the manner in which the sheep died it seems very probable it must be a poisonous weed which is the cause of the trouble, and the two weeds or plants obtainable at this time of the year on the range that are known to be poisonous are lark-
