The natives prize the rhino's horns dearly. They make cups from them, which, they say, betray the presence of any poison in drinks.

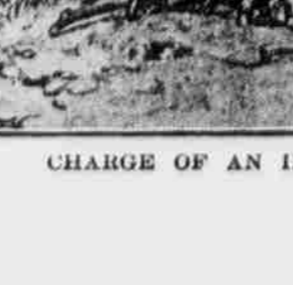
