A California Paper Has
Erroneous Ideas as
to This Town

Quincy, Calif., Bulletin, 10—
J. F. Mayfield and family re-

Lakeview, Oregon. Mr. Mayfield
was particularly well pleased with
the rich farming lands in the vicinity of
Likely—indeed, he thinks that
such lands form the basis of Oregon's
future prosperity and wealth. Al-
turess, the county seat, is destined to
become a territorial center, and, there-
fore, is sure to grow into a pretentious
business center in that part of
California.





This unique concrete block bungalow, originally built at Woodlawn Park, on the shore of Chautauqua lake, New York, has been universally admired by all who have seen it. The broad veranda, with octagonal floor, and the open balcony above command a magnificent view for miles up and down and across the lake, and sitting as it does among beautiful overhanging shade trees, it is an ideal spot to pass away one's summer vacation. Though built mainly for summer use, it is fully plastered and finished throughout as any town house would be and can be used the year round with comfort, the concrete blocks keeping out the cold lake winds, and the large open fireplace of cement brick makes all comfortable within. The color of the block is brown sandstone, and the roof shingles are stained red, a combination giving considerable life to the structure. Cost complete, \$3,000.
