MINES AND MINING

There are mining "experts" and mining experts. For instance the Alturas Plaindealer, of the 2nd inst., tells of one of that gentry, who travel about knocking new mining camps of acknowledged worth, as follows:

B. L. Mason gives an example of how the Hoss mine has been turned down by so-called mining experts. During the spring one Harrington, a gentleman from Nowhere, was sent, or least started to the district. He got as far as Bluff, six miles from the nearest claim, stopped there a few days and returned, reporting at Reno and at other places that there "was nothing there—all bunting." His judgment was formed from a distance of six miles.

Alturas New Era, 20 ult.: We hear that there are many new mining men arriving at Bidwell, and all are well pleased with that district. The mine owners of that district are very well pleased with the way the mines are

showing up, and expect when the custom mill soon to be in operation.

The Alturas Plaindealer, of the 2nd inst. says: R. L. Mason, superintendent of the Bidwell Consolidated, was a visitor this week. He informs us that work on the group of claims is being pushed as fast as possible. Two night and day shifts will be put in a few days to push the work. At a depth of 150 feet the mine shows rich values, an eight inch streak going \$300.00 with a three foot streak along side going \$300.00 to the ton. Mr. Mason says the deeper he gets the richer the ore, while the gold is much coarser than at the surface. He says others companies are also pushing development work. The snow is off the mountains and many miners are daily entering the district.

A miner named Ed Hyatt was killed by falling down a 400 foot shaft of the Golden Eagle mine with a carload of ore. He was working on the 100 foot level, and expecting the cage to receive it pushed the car into the shaft, with above result. The mine is in Modoc Co., California.
