HAWLEY SUPPORTS THE INCOME TAX

Salem Congressman IS Doing His Best for Its Passage

One of the warm supporters of the resolution to amend the constitution of the United States so that Congress shall have power to levy and collect taxes on incomes is Congressman Willis C. Hawley, of Salem. He supported the measure in the house and worked hard for its passage. This amendment is now ready for the approval of the president and the resolution is as follows:

Resolved by the Senate and house of representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled (two thirds of each house concurring therein), that the following article be proposed as an amendment to the constitution of the United States, which, when ratified by the legislatures of three fourths of the several states, shall be valid to all intents and purposes as a part of the constitution:

"Article XVI. The Congress shall have power to lay and collect taxes on incomes, from whatever source derived, without apportionment among the several states, and without regard to any census or enumeration."

NOTICE OF RESTORATION OF PUBLIC LANDS TO SETTLEMENT AND ENTRY.

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of the Interior has vacated departmental order of withdrawal in so far as the same affects the withdrawal for irrigation purposes under the act of June 17, 1902 (32 Stat., 388), for use in connection with the Pitt River Project, Or.-Cal., of the following described lands in the State of Oregon, and by his authority such said tracts as have not been heretofore finally restored and are not otherwise withdrawn, reserved or appropriated, will be subject to settlement under the public land laws of the United States on and after August 16, 1909, but shall not be subject to entry, filing or selection until September 15, 1909, at the United States land office at Lakeview Oregon, warning being expressly given that no person will be permitted to gain or exercise any right whatever under any settlement or occupation begun after May 10, 1909, and prior to August 16, 1909, all such settlement or occupation being forbidden:

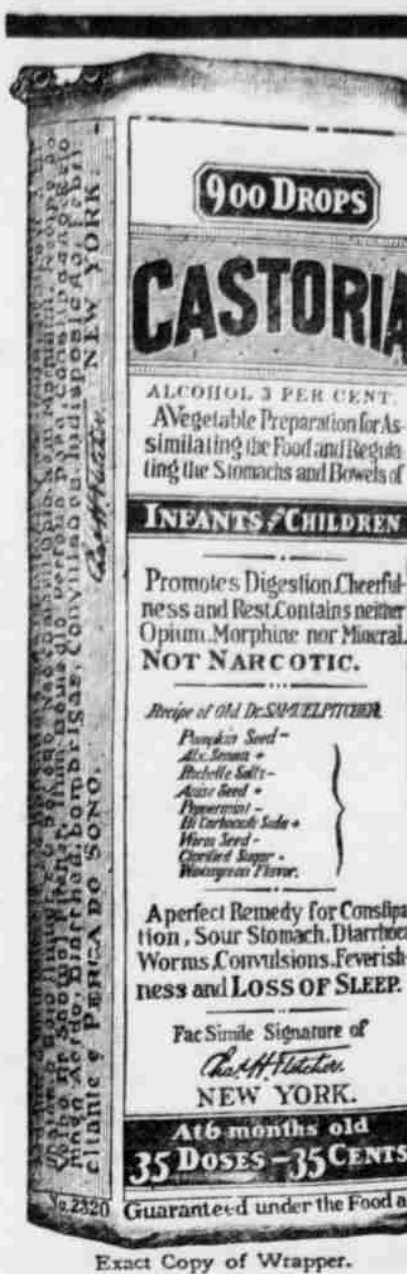
