Home Course In Modern Agriculture

III.—Preparing the Ground

SINCE the condition of the soil has so much to do with the readiness with which the plants can get food from it one of the most important problems that confront the farmer is the proper preparation of the ground.

will take into a hard clod. The furrow slice will also turn up cloddy if the soil is too dry.

A good way to tell when a field is in proper condition to be plowed is to squeeze a ball of the dirt in your hand. If it sticks together in a pasty mass you had better let it dry a few days longer.

ry attachments. By using them all the trash can be turned under completely. This not only hastens the decay of such matter, but also adds greatly to the looks of the field.

If the plowing is done in the fall it does not matter so much whether it turns up cloddy or not. The hard freezes of winter are the best pulverizers that ever tore a clod to pieces.

While plowing stalk ground is unnecessary, it will usually be found profitable to disk the land before seeding. This chops up the cornstalks and provides a mellow layer of soil for the seed to germinate in.

one disking before sowing and one afterward will cover them better than two after sowing. The drill is becoming more popular for sowing oats, and justly so. It places the seed at an even depth and covers them all.

In some parts of the corn belt the practice of listing corn is followed. This consists in throwing up a large furrow and planting the corn in the bottom of it.
