## VACANCIES FOR FOREST RANGERS NOW AVAILABLE

Portland, Ore., Aug. 27.—An examination to fill vacancies in the ranger force on all National Forests in District 6 will be held Oct. 25 and 26.

From this examination it is expected that 75 appointments will be made on National Forests in this district.

The examination will be held at the headquarters of the National Forest in the District, at the toll wing places: Kotlikian, Alaska, Eugene, Grants Pass, Heppner, John Day, Lakeview, Medford, Prineville, Portland, Roseburg, Sumpter, and Walla Walla, Oregon; and Bellingham, Cowlitz, Leavenworth, Newport, Olympia, Orting, Republic, Seattle, and Walla Walla, Washington.

While the examination is along entirely practical lines and knowledge of field conditions rather than book learning is considered essential, the opportunities for those applicants with educational advantages are considerably increased. The rapid de-

velopment of the National Forest is making continually increasing demands upon those engaged in their management, and men with ability to assume responsibility and serve in supervisory capacities are in demand. These responsible positions on National Forests are filled by promotion from lower grades, so that anyone entering as a ranger is eligible for promotion to any of the more responsible and higher places, including that of Forest Supervisor.

Only those men who are at least 21 years of age, not more than 40 of good character, temperament and in good physical condition, are eligible to take this examination. The salary paid to beginners is \$800 per year.

Applicants can secure information concerning the examination from the District Forester at Portland, Oregon, Forest Supervisor of the United States Civil Service Commission, Washington D. C.

## WENATCHEE APPLE CROP IS SHORT

The apple crop of Wenatchee valley will not exceed 50 to 70 per cent of 1905, besides total failure; pears 90 per cent of last year. A great variation is noticeable in the same varieties in the same orchard; some trees loaded and others entirely bare, making it difficult to estimate the yield with accuracy. We will be short on the Jonathan and Ben Davis, not over 10 per cent of Jonathans and 20 per cent of Bens. Quality should be fine and average size large. Winesaps fine and large, but light yield season, so far has been very favorable. Damage from codling moth very light. No scale, no scab, no blight of any description yet visible. Apple shipping season opens about October 1. Bartlett pears will start about Aug. 20—Wenatchee Fruit Growers Association, E. T. Balch, sales manager.
