PAISLEY AND SUMMER LAKE

Joe Howard, the cattle king of Squaw creek, who has the contract to supply beef to the Oregon Trunk contractors, is feeding three hundred head of cattle at Summer Lake on the Harvey, Withers and McCormack places.

The big drain ditch put in by the ZX on the Chewocan marsh was completed last Saturday. It is twenty feet between levees and runs from the Jones place nine miles to the lower end of the marsh.

The settlers in Christmas Lake valley have subscribed thirty seven hundred dollars to make a test for artesian water. The machinery was to arrive last Saturday from Shaniko. A well will be bored 2,000 feet, or until it strikes an artesian flow, near the Phelps place on the west side, close to the line between ranges 17 and 18.

The petitions protesting against a further extension of time to the Portland Irrigation company were being circulated in Paisley last Saturday by Al Farrow. There are three copies, one to be presented to the state land board, one to Congressman Hawley and the other to the secretary of the interior. The petitions were evidently prepared by the attorneys for the Protestants, Conn and Benson, and cover ten typewritten pages. They recite that the company has not acted

in good faith but is holding 12,000 acres for speculative purposes, and allege that the land will grow crops without irrigation. The people in Paisley are practically unanimous in signing the protest.

John Hannon and Miss Paul Sult were married Sunday at the home of the bride's parents at Summer Lake.

Twenty-three pounds of potatoes were dug from one hill on Dr. Withams ranch at White Hill. Can any one beat it?

Stephen Rankin has accepted a position in Virgil Conn's store. With his wife and family he is occupying the Bennett residence. Mr. Rankin came out from Kansas recently and drew a hundred and sixty acres of land on the Malheur-Barney line from the Oregon Valley Land Company.

MINES AND MINING

Something was transpiring in mining circles in Lakeview last week as most of the principal stock holders in the Goldberg (Windy Hollow) mines were registered at the Lakeview Hotel.

Mr. L. C. Beckwith, Arthur Philbrick, Fred Oliver and E. J. Reilly will keep men working on the mines through the winter, and in the spring expect to install a mill with which to extract the free milling gold from the ores.

On the Jumbo Chief shaft they have installed a hoisting apparatus and will proceed to hoist ore during the winter, then when the mill is ready there will be sufficient ore to keep it running and they will be grinding out their own gold in quantities to suit.

An eastern man who lately inspected the Jumbo Chief, stated that it had the best showing of any mine he had seen in the past few years, and as they sink on the rich fluid that was made a month ago he believes it will increase in value.

To have a booming mining camp a few miles from Lakeview will mean much to the growth of the town, for this is the natural supply center of the Goldberg camp, and for this reason the citizens of this county should help a good thing along, for by so doing they will benefit themselves. The owners of the mines have

showed good faith in all they have done, and have carried it beyond the experimental stage and for their persistent work they have their just reward, in the way the mines are showing up.
