From the Life of St. Pat- Here's a Pointer for Road rick, by Archbishop Healy, of Tuam

St. Patrick was not alone to his work; others shared in this magnauimous project. When he had set out from Rome to evangelize ireland in the year 432, he led a devoted band of followers from the continent, bish ops, priests, deacons, lectors, acolytes, and other clerics whom he ordained and trained for the arduous but learned and practised their respective duties, until be placed them, in due time . in charge of newly established churches or monasteries, which at once became centres of learning and bives of industry, so that ireland, in an incredibly brief space of time merited her proud title "Island of Saints and Scholars," which she sus tained for centuries. Armagh became not only the holy city of Ireland, but the chief home of act, where St Benignus, from the banks of the Boyne, was choir leader of the school BY THIS PLAN

constantly recruited from the schools of the native bards and brehons, and from the Irish families converted by the Saint. Thus St. Erc, St. Benin. St. Bron, St. Finore and many other trish boys were trained by St. Pat rick who, on returning to their respective claus, in the course of his mission, ordained these and placed them with due authority to rule the congregation with ability to teach and the duty of assisting the poor, the afflicted, and the penitent. Church and State worked together in zealous harmony for the benefit of all classes, especially the most needy.
As a rule, wherever St. Patrick
found a resident chief of a clau, be established a bishop's see, so that the ancient dioceses of Ireland coin-cide, more or less, with the territories once occupied by the clans and their respective groups of sun-claus, and not with the counties, which are a more modern division of the land. st. Patrick did not interfere with what he found good or blameless in the pagan institutions of Ireland. He protected and encourged the bards and the brehons (judges), but he purified many of the poems and had the laws raised, improved and codified; the result being the great Senchus Mor written A. D 438-441 at Tara and Nobber, and composed by a comission of nine, -three bishops, three kings (High King and kings of Munster and Ulster and three judges. it prevailed in a great part of Ireland until A. D. 1600 and its influence is still felt in the habits and feelings of the people It was last interpreted in the last quarter of the seventeenth century by the Mac Egans, who kept a law school in Tipperary. These laws dealt with two forms land tenure, payment of rent, the rights every clansman, legally qualified, to a share of the land; besides these and other important matters, they also dealt with the fosterage and education of girls and boys, and the letting of church lands to the poor under conditions that secured them a livelihood for their families. Many traits of the national character can be traced to the influence of the Senchus Mor to the exalted morality and self control inculcated by St. Patrick and
