**HOAG DISTRICT IS MAKING GOOD**

MILL IN OPERATION IN TEN DAYS

Much Development Work Under Way and Camp a sure Winner

FERN CAMP: Pine Creek, June 25.—The wagon road from Pine Creek to the mines will be completed by next Saturday, July 2nd.

Conditions on the mountain are growing intensely interesting, new miners are coming in, new leases are being let, and now, with milling facilities, almost a realization, the Hoag District will register a good account of herself this season.

Mr. Wall, of the Quartz mill, was up to see us yesterday. He says the mine will be ready to grind ore in ten days.

The Bassler, Brown lease on the Bonanza, have a machine hoist installed and are hoisting ore from both the east drift and bottom of the shaft.

A Los Angeles man has taken a lease on the ground adjoining the sunshine of the west, and started work yesterday.

Mr. J. F. Cutler, who, last fall purchased two hundred and sixty acres of patented ground, in the Hoag District, is now here and making arrangements to begin work of establishing permanent camp and will soon start development work on their property.

McCleary & Schaubers are sinking the shaft on the high grade ore chute, which was opened on the Mountain Sheep, last October.

Dick Mason is mining some nice ore on the mountain view.

Mr. Cantfield will start work on the Alturas group within a few days.

The Hoag District will have established a place for herself on the big map by the close of the season of 1910.

Messrs. Easton and Stout, of the Pandango Saw Mill, were in town Thursday and Friday of last week on a business trip. They report that business at the mill is very brisk just now. Mrs. Emrich and daughter, who came here from Texas, and stopped in Lakeview for a short time, are running the boarding house for the crew.

**Talk of Big Auto Race**

W. L. Clapp claims the record for an auto between here and Klamath Falls, the actual elapsed time between leaving and arriving being five hours and 20 minutes. The actual running time was probably close to five hours, several stops having been for water. Mr. Clapp is authority for the statement that every effort is being made to pull off a big race from Lakeview to Klamath Falls on the Fourth between H. P. Hoey's and Locomobile Senator Weed's Franklin. Both machines have been in Lakeview and were greatly admired by auto enthusiasts. Both are noted for their speed and endurance, and should the race take place the time would probably be close to the four hour mark.

Relative to the proposed race the Klamath Chronicle says: An automobile race is being planned between Senator Abner Weed, of Stikyou county, and H. P. Hoey Chief Engineer for the Southern Pacific, to take place here July 4th.

The course for this race is between Klamath Falls and Lakeview, a distance of 110 miles. The race is to start at Lakeview on the morning of the fourth and this city is to be the goal. While all of the details for this air raising part of the celebration to be pulled off here on the Fourth and Fifth it is stated that Senator Weed has challenged Mr. Hoey for this race with a side bet of \$2,000, the car making the quickest time to be the winner.

Mr. Weed's Oldsmobile car has made the run just in the ordinary travel from Lakeview to this city in five hours and 35 minutes while Mr. Hoey came from that place a few days ago in five hours and 40 minutes in his Locomobile. These trips were made without any particular incentive for running above the average speed and it is thought when these two big "bug" wagons get on the same road with a prize purse of \$2,000 as an incentive to get up speed they will cut this time in half at least. Much interest will center in this contest as both men are dead game sports and when they enter a contest of this kind will go in to do or die.
