"receive," "ask," "solicit." and like terms, with their corresponding nouss, shall apply to money, its equivalent, or any other valuable thing; shall include the promise, mivance, deposit, borrow ing or loss thereof, and shall cover all or any part of a transaction, whether it be made directly or indi-

Every candidate for nomination to election whall file with the proper officer, after election, an itemized sworn statemen setting forth in detail all the money contributed, expended or promised by him to aid and promote his nomination or election, or both, as the case may be, and for the election of his party candidates, and all existing unfulfilled promises of every character and all liabilities remaining uncancelled and in force at the time such statement is made, whether such expenditures, promises, and liabilities were made or incurred before, during or after such election.

Every candidadte who shall fail to

promote his nomination or election directly or indirectly himself or chrough any other person promise to appoint another person, or promise to secure or aid in securing the appointment, nomination or election of another person to any public or private position or employment, or to any position of honor, trust or

emulument. No person shall invite or demand or accept payment or contribution from any holder of a public position or office, for campaign purposes. No person shall demand, solicit, ask or anvite any payment, or contribution for any religious, political charitable or other causs or organization sup-, osed to primarily or principally for the public good, from a person who seeks to be or has been nominated or elected to any office, and no such candidate for elected person shall make any such payment or contribution if it shall be demanded or asked during the time he is candidate for momination or election to or an incumbent of any omce. 
