

Aside from the local fire wardens, of whom there will be about ROOSE six hundred in the state, supervising wardens are being appointed in each of the heavily timbered counties. In that part of the state having but a small amount of timber, two or more counties will be looked afetr by one supervising warden. Mr. Chas. C. Chitwood, of Klamath Falls. has been appointed to the position of supervising warden for Klamath and Lake counties This appointment was made by the State Forester after a very careful consideration of the recommendations received from the principle timber land owners of this territory. 
