Lot 1 was given no salt; one-half ounce per day was given to lot 2; and threefourths ounce per day per head was fed to lot 3. The sheep in lot 2, gained 4 1-2 pounds per head more than those in lot 1, and 1 1-4 pounds more per head than those in lot 3. The conclusion was drawn that too much salt can be given as well as too little. The sheep fed on salt produced 1.75 pounds more wool and had a better fleece than those given no salt.
