Impending Conflict with Islam is Seen

Detroit, Mich., Nov. 27.—The shadow of an impending conflict between the civilizations of the western world and that of Islam, was pictured Wednesday by James G. McDonald, chairman of the Foreign Policy Association of New York City, addressing the Congress on Peace and Security.

The revolt in China, Mr. McDonald saw as a result of Russian propaganda, a reaction to western commercialism, and enmity between Germany and Poland. But Mr. McDonald saw a slight ray of hope in the results of the Laccarum conference.

"Laccarum," he said, "is the European states' last, most dramatic and probably most far-reaching answer to the criticism that they cannot live in peace."
