All of the persons lynched were Negroes. The offenses charged were murder, 4; attempted murder, 2; rape, 1; improper conduct, 1; charge not reported, 1.

(Continued from page one) or he would be slain. He said a gang of masked whites came to his home and carried him off in an automobile to a point about seven miles away in a woods.

Fear of Return

Fear of the return of the floggers, he said, led him to sell his land which he values at \$12,000 for \$800.

Scars and ugly welts on on Hitts' back and legs and a large gash over his forehead bear out his story.

Probe Crime

Authorities are conducting a rigid investigation of the flogging of Hitt and hope to run down his assailants. The deed to the property in question will be looked up.

Officers Brown and Bewly have also changed their first testimony and now claim that they were not even in the neighborhood where Sheffield and Randolph raided the Faulkner home in which the dead man lost his life from a bullet fired by one of the officers.

Brown and Bewly had formerly testified that they entered the home and found Faulkner with a gun clutched in his right hand. With officer Randolph they testified this past week that they were drilled to tell the story by Sheffield after Sheffield had been in conference with Chief of Police Davis.

They gave he perjured testimony they said in order to save their jobs. Sheffield told them that the Chief of Police Davis was 100 per cent behind them.

So far only the prosecution has presented its case and it will take at least two more days to complete it. Jude White, attorney for Sheffield will present the defense angle.

Large crowds continue to attend the trial and daily papers have an extra on the street every day.

There seems to be some truth to the rumor that a special election is being advocated by some of the leading citizens to attempt to do away with our Commission form of government in favor of the former Aldermanic form of governing the city.

ONLY COLORED WOMAN ELIGIBLE TO D. A. R. DEAD

(By Pacific Coast News Bureau) Lexington, Ky., July—Lizzie Shelton, said to be the only colored woman ever eligible to membership in the Daughters of the American Revolution, died here a few days ago.

Lizzie Shelton was the great granddaughter of "Captain" Jack Hart, noted Negro, who was the body guard of Nathaniel Hart, pioneer of Boonesboro, Kentucky.

Nathaniel Hart was the uncle of John I. Hart, of Santa Clara, Oregon, who knew Lizzie Shelton well and is the authority for the statement that while eligible to membership in the D. A. R., she never became a member.

Mrs. Shelton obtained the eligibility because of the services in the war of her great grandfather, "Captain Jack."

Chicago, Ill. (A. N. P.)—Correspondence with Secretary John Harriman of the United States Board of Mediation for disputes between railway employers and em- ployed statements that the Board had finally dismissed the case presented by A. Philip Randolph, as general organizer of the Brotherhood of Sleeping Car Porters were not true.

Instead, the Mediation Board indefinitely postponed consideration of the complaints compiled by Mr. Randolph, holding that it found no cause to consider them at this time, and that it could not be proved that the general organizer represented a majority of the porters.
