Thoughts for a Thousand Sermons

There is no doubt, that the Negro minister unrecognized as such, is the greatest prophet in the world. Excepting the type of Billy Sunday, the Negro preacher in America almost alone cries out against evil. The white pulpit has been silent about the prostitution of American youth to crime by yellow journalism, which has become a nursery of criminal instruction. The white pulpit has been silent about the folly that has disintegrated the white home and the savagery of mob-rule.

Of course there have been exceptions but it did not take long to set in motion the machinery to crucify such pastors; so it remains in America for the Negro minister almost alone to cry out against error and folly. Before they were legislated off their favorite street-corners true they caught a glimpse of their giant statue, as they stood up to tell white folk face to face of the sins of prejudice and race-hate and the white man admiring their courage silently took it.

I remember a story I read in the

"Daily Oklahoman" of the Reverend Duncan who for many years owned a street corner down town. The lady writer spoke of him affectionately. She told of his logic and fervor and of how she had seen white men of intelligence and worth kneel in the snow as he prayed. These men were the VOICE of God to white people. They would not have taken this truth from a lettered Negro but humbly took it from the lips of this untutored street preacher.

A great many people do not know that in ante-bellum days old Master would go to hear these old prophets preach. In the day of the late C. T. Walker of Augusta Georgia man cultured Aryans visiting the South were regular attendants of his magnificent tabernacle. Now that he is gone let us point the lesson of their mission. These men are latter day prophets, and the great mistake of the race lies in not taking down and preserving their messages for the future generations.

We are asking you to take down the points of some of these wonderful discourses and send them to us with the speakers names and we will see that they are preserved. Ethiopians in very primitive ages gave the cult of religion to the world. Listen to this incident. One of our leading ministers went back home in the far South. On Sunday morning he witnessed the arrival of the pastor in charge. He was curiously constructed with a very long head. When he heard the text he was settled in the conviction that this man was a fool. The text was "You can't whop him." This unlettered man proceeded to prove with the power of inspired logic that you can't whip God. Innumerable ways he settled this in the conviction of his hearers. When he thought this conscientiously done, he closed with this clinching climax: "If we can't whop him, lets jine him." His skeptical visitors decided that only a foolish man that morning could have resisted jining.
