Guest at Coronation Guest at Coronation Here he remained for many years doing the same service as he had done for the Prince Lobkowitz. When Francis I died and Joseph II was to be crowned in his place at Frank-fort, Germany. Angelo went with the Prince of Lichtenstein to the corona-tion tion

At Frankfort he met the young emperer, Joseph II, for the first time,

emperor, Joseph II, for the first time, and a friendship began between the two that was to last until the death of the emperor January 30, 1790. Maria Theresa, empress of Aus-tria, and mother of Joseph, had given orders that Joseph should be educated as if learning were play. Joseph, becoming keenly interested in Angelo, invited him to his palace as well as to his apartments in the magnificent Schonbrunn Palace where the two would be seen together where the two would be seen together at all hours of the day. They called each other by their first names, and would stroll about the palace grounds and the city togeth

Friend of Emperor The young emperor, it is said, "even took Angelo's arm in promenading." Angelo with his wider experience, and noble and cultivated mind, did

much to influence the emperor. Later, Joseph succeeded to the throne of Austria, becoming one of the most liberal and enlightened of all rulers. He was a friend to relig-ious tolerance, which his mother. Maria Theresa, had not been. He did all he could to improve the lot of the peasants and to spread know-ledge. His motto was: "Reason and Eveloptemment" Enlightenment.

Secret Exposed

Secret Exposed Before this, however, Joseph was unwittingly to be the cause of a quarrel between Angelo and the Prince de Lichtenstein. Angelo had been secretly married for some years without the knowledge or consent of the prince. He had, however, confided in the young emperor, and the latter, in conversation with the prince one day, let slip a remark that led to the exposure of Angelo's secret. secret.

The prince, in anger, banished Angelo from the palace, and struck his name from his will. Among the things he had destined for him was a superb diamond that Angelo used to wear on his turban when he rode with the prince on great parades or on holidays.

His ad-versary, eager for revenge, bet him another 20,000. Angelo played and won, but knowing that his opponent would be ruined offered to play him, on which he arranged the cards so skillfully that the other won back the second bet. This act of delicacy, it is said, won him much admira-tion and praise. When his wife died Angelo was so deeply affected that he decided to retire permanently from court life. Gaining the permission of the prince he returned to his suburban home. Here he spent the days educating his daughter, the Haronness of Heuchtersleben. He received no more friends at his table, leading as re-tired a life a spossible. To set his child the example he draik only water. Perennial Youth
