AVOID OVERPLANTING, FARMERS ARE WARNED

Legge, Board Chairman, Gives Out Timely Hint.

Washington.—Farmers of America have been warned by Alexander Legge, chairman, that the federal farm board cannot hope to offer relief for growers who overplant. Continued overproduction, he said, will defeat any stabilization program and the board plans only to take care of surpluses caused by higher acreage yields and not those caused by excess planting. Legge said there has been a favorable reaction by southern cotton farmers to the board's recent warning against overproduction.

Washington.—Having successfully launched national co-operative organizations for the cotton growers, the wheat growers and the wool men, the federal farm board in all probability will turn to the task of organizing a national marketing organization for the fruit and vegetable growers.

Thirty representatives of fruit and vegetable co-operative associations met here recently with members of the farm board to discuss such a project. No decision was reached. The task is a big one and probably will take some time to formulate.

Discussions centered around three specific points that were laid down by the farm board. These were:

Whether it is advisable to attempt an organization of two or more of the groups into a national sales organization.

Whether it is advisable to organize these groups separately, by commodities into national co-operative sales organizations.

Whether some plan of production loans may be worked out that will enable co-operatives to obtain a larger percentage of commodities which now are controlled through production financing.

In addition to the specific questions the board wishes to discuss the problem of making more effective means for removing surpluses from the fresh fruit and vegetable market. That, it was said, would involve operation of co-operative canning and packing plants.

Dairy Farmers Warned by the Federal Board

Washington.—Warning that an over-production of dairy products exists, the federal farm board's dairy advisory commodity committee urged farmers to cut down production, slaughter less profitable cows, and to beware of promotional schemes for further construction of physical facilities.

"We recommend the sale for slaughter of all low-producing and unprofitable cows from the herd," the bulletin said. "The price of production and farmers are themselves partly responsible because of their failure to use their own products in their homes."

"The experience of past years discloses that farmers have been victimized by schemes to construct and equip packing plants, creameries and various kinds of factories for processing their products, under conditions that did not reflect sound business judgment."

"There is imminent danger that many unscrupulous persons may seek to take advantage of the present sweeping co-operative marketing movement by similar unsound schemes."
