### JOHN LOWE

John Lowe is dead. The mortal house in which he lived now reposes amid the quietude of Lincoln Memorial Cemetery.

In the balmy days of recent years Portland and Oregon knew John Lowe as a spectacular figure. He was called a bootlegger. Information of his conviction upon this charge is not at hand but at least, it is known that Lowe never denied that he handled liquor. Rumor names among his customers some of the foremost citizens of Oregon. Business and professional men of note, whose appetites for strong drink did not pass with the passage of the bone-dry law. By a process of reason that finds some justification in fact if not in law, Lowe believed that a practice sanctioned and encouraged by so many men of high standing could not be wholly criminal.

John Lowe was uneducated. Doubtless his own native Southland denied him the normal opportunity of education. It is said that he could not even write his own name, but certainly he had a very clear mind. His ingenuity was shown in the allegation that he influenced two hardened criminals to attempt a bold and daring robbery. For this he was sentenced to twenty years in prison. Admittedly a rather stiff sentence, for as John said, "men who kill their wives sometimes get off lighter than that." The gates of the prison had already opened for the men who did the job, but John remained inside the grim walls, where, it is said by inmates of the prison, he became ill and literally died of a broken heart.

Lowe was persistent in his claim of innocence, but the jury decided he was not. After his incarceration he reformed. He was converted and became a Christian, and promised, if ever released, he would lead a different life.

Whatever many may think of the life of John Lowe, those who knew him are aware that he was not wholly bad. Receipts from the Community Chest show his contributions to the poor and needy, and doubtless many others had received help from his charitable hand.

On the very day he died friends in Portland had gathered to discuss plans to secure his release, for they felt that he had been sufficiently punished, and in view of the fact that he was hopelessly ill, they hoped that he might not die in prison. And since his companions in the crime had been released—those who actually committed the deed—there was apparent justification for seeking his release.

Lowe's effort to do good in the world seems against society whatever they were, but we do believe that he was "more to be pitied than scorned", and may a kind-hearted world judge him not too harshly.


