

Pare the apples, core them carefully, and cut in half-inch pieces. Make a rich sirup, I cup of sugar to I cup of water. Add the pieces of apple to the boil f sirup. Cut left-over meat and vegetables into uniform medium-sized pieces. Mix with an equal amount of medium cream sauce (I c. milk, 2 tbsp. flour, 2 tbsp. butter). Beat yolk with % cup sugar, add coffee and fruit juice, cook in double boiler until thick. Beat egg whites until stiff, and % cup sugar, fold in-to the cooked mixture while very hot. Pour at once into baked pie shell and brown in oven.

1 junket tablet

pint milk
tablespoon cold water
cup sugar
tup boiling water
teaspoon vanfila

Crush junket tablet and dissolve in cold water. Put sugar in a small saucepan and heat, stirring constant-ly, until melted and golden brown. Add water and dissolve sugar in it.

Bread Pudding Dessert

1 package lemon junket
1 pint milk
4 slices bread
butter
Remove crusts from bread, butter
lightly and cut in small cubes. Divide the cubed bread among dessert

Add milk to caramel syrup and warm until lukewarm—not hot. Remove from stove. Add dissolved tablet and vanilla- and turn at once into individual dessert glasses. Let stand in a warm room until firm (about 70 minutes); then chill before serving.

Wash each staik of asparagus carefully with a vegetable brush to remove all grit. Then cut in small pieces (using all but the very tough parts). Cook, covered, until the asparagus is tender, in enough water to cover. Add salt to taste just before the asparagus is done. Allow 2 cups cooked saparagus and cooking water to 2 cups medium cream sauce (2 c milk 4 tbsps. flour, 4 tbsps. butter). Season, and serve hot.

Note: The less tender part may be cooked longer and put through a sieve. (If desired, the tops may be used for salad.)
