Appetizing Sauces

Sauce Tartare
This sauce adds greatly to the appetite appeal of fried oysters, scallops, smelts and many other varieties of fish. Mix together one-half teaspoon mustard, one-half teaspoon

Apple Compote

Pare the apples, core them carefully, and cut in half-inch pieces. Make a rich syrup, 1 cup of sugar to 1 cup of water. Add the pieces of apple to the boil; sirup. Cook till the apples are transparent. Commercial coloring matter or cinnamon candies added to the sirup give the apples a pleasing color. These apple slices are very pretty as a garnish for meats.

LEFT-OVER MEAT PIE

Cut left-over meat and vegetables into uniform medium-sized pieces. Mix with an equal amount of medium cream sauce (1 c. milk, 2 tbsp. flour, 2 tbsp. butter). Season well with onion, salt, pepper, etc. (Use left-over gravy with cream sauce if possible). Cover with a thick pie crust, biscuit dough, or layer of left-over mashed potato mixed with milk (one slightly beaten egg can be added to potato if desired). Bake in a moderate oven until the crust is cooked, or until browned and heated through if potato is used.

Four Fruit Salad

1 package lime-flavored gelatin.
1½ cups boiling water
1 orange, sections free from membrane and diced
1 banana, diced
1 apple, pared and diced
Juice of one lemon
½ cup sugar
Dash of salt
Dissolve gelatin in boiling water. Chill. Combine remaining ingredients. When gelatin is slightly thickened, fold in fruit mixture; turn into mold. Chill until firm. Unmold on crisp lettuce and garnish with mayonnaise, or serve with whipped cream as a dessert. Serves 6.

Bread Pudding Dessert

1 package lemon junket
1 pint milk
4 slices bread
butter
raisins

Remove crusts from bread, butter lightly and cut in small cubes. Divide the cubed bread among dessert dishes and add a few seeded raisins. Warm the milk to lukewarm—not hot; add the lemon junket. Stir until dissolved; pour over bread. Let stand in a warm place until firm—then chill. Sprinkle with a mixture of sugar and cinnamon before serving.

Coffee Chiffon Pie

3 egg yolks
3 egg whites
1 cup sugar
3 tablespoons brewed coffee
2 tablespoons lemon juice or 6 tablespoons orange juice.

Beat yolk with ¼ cup sugar, add coffee and fruit juice, cook in double boiler until thick. Beat egg whites until stiff, and ¼ cup sugar, fold into the cooked mixture while very hot. Pour at once into baked pie shell and brown in oven.

CARAMEL JUNKET

1 junket tablet
1 pint milk
1 tablespoon cold water
¼ cup sugar
¼ cup boiling water
½ teaspoon vanilla

Crush junket tablet and dissolve in cold water. Put sugar in a small saucepan and heat, stirring constantly, until melted and golden brown. Add water and dissolve sugar in it.

salt, few grains cayenne and one teaspoon powdered sugar. Add yolks of two eggs. Stir until thoroughly blended, setting bowl in pan of ice water. Add drop by drop at first, one-half cup olive oil, stirring with wooden spoon or wire whisk. Dilute very gradually with one and a half tablespoons vinegar as the mixture thickens, at the same time adding the oil more rapidly. Keep in the refrigerator until just before serving. Then add one tablespoon tarragon vinegar, one-half shallot chopped fine, and one-half tablespoon each of finely chopped capers, pickles, olives and parsley.

Horseradish Sauce

This is good with any seafood. Mix together one cup horseradish, one-fourth teaspoon dry mustard, two tablespoons sugar, and juice of one-half lemon. Heat in double boiler. Add slowly one-half cup sweet cream and cook until thick. Then add one tablespoon butter.

A DELICIOUS DISH OFT ILL-PREPARED

Cream of Asparagus

Wash each stalk of asparagus carefully with a vegetable brush to remove all grit. Then cut in small pieces (using all but the very tough parts). Cook, covered, until the asparagus is tender, in enough water to cover. Add salt to taste just before the asparagus is done. Allow 2 cups cooked asparagus and cooking water to 2 cups medium cream sauce (2 c. milk 4 tbsps. flour, 4 tbsps. butter). Season, and serve hot.

Note: The less tender part may be cooked longer and put through a sieve. (If desired, the tops may be used for salad.)
