Another basket is called the Above, a King's chair from Liberia, It is used by the heads of tribes, as a chair placed on the head. The wemen of Liberia make most of these things and are very skillful in weaving mats of grass and raffia-like material.

Elephant hoofs are used for bracelets, and many of them have delicate silver inlay. Miss Hocks secured a pair of jingling contrivances which the natives wear around their ankles in dancing. She also has ivory beads, napkin rings, and other ivery carv-
