His poems, as was said, bear a striking resemblance to those of David:

"How manifold are Thy works. Thou didst create the earth according to Thy desires—men, all cattle—all upon the earth."

"The world is in darkness like the dead. Every lion cometh forth from his den, all serpents sting. Darkness reigns. When Thou riseth in the horizon the darkness is banished. Then all the world do Thy work."

David speaks of God's being a "tower of defense." Akhenaton speaks of him as being "a wall of brass of a million cubits."

All of Akhenaton's psalms reflect the utmost joy:

"O Lord, how manifold are Thy works. The whole land is in joy and holiday because of Thee. They shout to the height of heaven; they receive joy and gladness when they see Thee."

Preached Christianity before Christ

Akhenaton uttered the words: "The kingdom of God is within you," long before Christ did so.

On his golden coffin he had engraved the words:

"I breathe the sweet breath which comes forth from Thy mouth; I behold Thy beauty every day. It is my desire that I may hear Thy sweet voice, even the north wind that my limbs may be rejuvenated with life through love of Thee. Give me Thy hands, holding Thy spirit, that I may receive it and live by it. Call Thou upon my name, and it shall never fail."

Face Shows Refinement

His bust in the Louvre shows a face of extraordinary sweetness, gentleness and refinement. It reminds one of Toussaint L'Ouverture's seen in profile.

Judged by prevailing standards, Akhenaton was far from being handsome. His skull, which has been preserved, is what some scientists call that of a typical Negro. It is exceedingly prognathous. His lips, as seen in profile, are so thick that they seem swollen (see Breasted's *History of Egypt*, p. 376, or on any of his later monuments). His father, Amenophis was Negroid, and his mother, Tiye, seemed to have been a full-blooded African. That his wife, Nefertiti, was one, cannot be denied.

Many ingenious theories have been advanced to account for the shape of his head and the thickness of his lips, some writers asserting that it was deformed. But as Maurice Pilet

says it is more logical to assume that they are "the characteristics of a race," especially since identically the same appears in his wife and daughters.

Resembles Tut-Ankh-Amen

Howard Carter, discoverer of the tomb of Tut-Ankh-Amen, says that he was especially struck by the resemblance that Tut-Ankh-Amen bore to Akhenaton, and the latter's mother, Queen Tiye.

Arthur Weigall has written a very fine life of Akhenaton, and both he and Prof. Breasted have included a number of his poems in their works. Akhenaton's "Hymn to the Sun," which is included, is one of the most majestic and moving compositions of its kind in all literature.

Herewith is the first verse of Akhenaton's famous hymn:

"Thy dawning is beautiful in the horizon of heaven,
O living Atin, beginning of life,
When Thou risest in the eastern horizon of the heavens
Thou fillst every land with Thy beauty,
For Thou art beautiful, great, glittering high over the earth.
Thy rays they encompass the lands; even all Thou hast made.
Thou art Ra, and Thou hast carried them all away captive;
Thou bindest them by Thy love,
Though Thou art afar, Thy rays are on earth;
Though Thou art on high, Thy footprints are the day."

Will the Brown Race Eventually Rule the Earth?

The Philippine Herald, nationalistic newspaper, quoted Manuel Roxas, Speaker of the House, as saying in a speech, the Philippines "were writhing in hell," and as predicting that some day the white man would fall and the brown race would rule the world.

The newspaper said that Roxas threw his audience at Santa Cruz, Laguna Province, into commotion when he bitterly declared:

"The Philippines are now writhing in the throes of hell, a hell of slavery and foreign domination. Our country, the greatest mother of us all, because she made us what we are and gave us what we have, is weeping, pleading, crying to us, her children, to come to her aid and save her from eternal damnation."

Predicting world supremacy of the brown race, Roxas said:

"All things have their rise and fall. The black man had his day of supreme power and glory. Black generals from Egypt, Carthage and Babylon once swept the plains of Europe and conquered the white peoples inhabiting that continent."

"The white man succeeded the black and today he still rules supreme. He still dominates and tyrannizes; he still looks down on all other races as inferior. But the day will come when whites will also bite the dust and taste the bitter fruit of tyranny. Then will come the brown man's turn. He will hold the world in his hands and rule supreme over all other races."

MUFFINS THAT ARE DIFFERENT

Vary your muffins occasionally. Every one will appreciate novelties, particularly when they are as delicious as the following:

Date Muffins

2 cups special cake flour, sifted
4 teaspoons baking powder
1/2 teaspoon salt
4 tablespoons sugar
1/2 cup milk
1 egg, well beaten
4 tablespoons butter or other shortening, melted
1 cup dates, seeded and sliced

Sift flour once, measure, add baking powder, salt, and sugar, and sift again. Combine milk and egg and add to flour, beating until smooth. Add shortening and dates. Bake in greased muffin pans in moderate oven (375 degrees F.) 30 minutes. Makes 18 small muffins.

2 egg yolks
1 cup cream
Whipped cream
Dissolve sugar in orange juice; add orange rind, egg yolks well beaten, and cream, and cook in double boil-

er, stirring constantly, until it begins to thicken. Chill and serve in glass cups, with whipped cream. The beaten whites of two eggs can be used in place of whipped cream, if desired.
