Therefore, to those in our race who are continually seeking opportunities but believe they must come through stirring up a racial or an emotial appeal, the sugestion is made that you thoroughly study the requirement of your community, study and master the technique of the particular field in which you wish to embark, surround yourself with associates who are equipped, through academic knowledge and actual experience, and then launch your enterprise, whatever it may be.
