## Fake Medicines Claim to Cure Stomach Ulcers

### Tasty Sweets Easily Prepared

#### QUEEN'S CAKES

Persons suffering from stomach ulcers, gallstones, cholecystitis, (inflammation of the gall bladder), and diseases of the liver, often deny themselves relief by resorting to fake medicines advertised as having remedial value for these serious diseases, according to Dr. F. J. Culien, Federal Food and Drug Administration. The nostrums advertised commonly contain alkalies, such as sodium bicarbonate, bis-muth subcarbonate, calcium carbonate, and milk of magnesia, which are falsely claimed as treatments in these disorders.

The government has seized scores of misbranded medical preparations recommended for these and other diseases of the gall bladder, stomach, and liver.

A recent seizure involved a product shipped by a Birmingham (Ala.) medical company. Composed of everyday chemicals which could have no remedial value for the diseases mentioned upon the label, the preparation was recommended for disorders of the kidneys, stomach, and liver.

"No drug nor combination of drugs is recognized by present-day medical science as being a cure for diseases of the liver, for stomach ulcers, nor will any of them remove gallstones," says Culien. "There is no medical nor dietary treatment for gallstones nor for cholecystitis. The buyer may be sure that any drug sold to dissolve gallstones or to cure inflammation of the gall bladder is a fraud."

"Some of the minor symptoms of these diseases may be alleviated and the patient made more comfortable through the use of medicines, a correct diet, and proper exercise. Basing its activities upon world-wide medical opinion, the Food and Drug Administration intends to continue its campaign against falsely labeled medical preparations."

Make into long round-sided loaf. Wrap in waxed paper. Put into refrigerator over night. Slice and bake in oven at 400 degrees F. until light brown. The dough will keep well and can be used as wanted. Keep wrapped.

To make a dry mop take an old broom handle and tie pieces of cloth firmly onto one end. Sift the pieces of cloth into inch wide strips, dip in kerosene, and let it drip for several hours, or over-night, before using.

In order to remove rust stains from linen, soak in sour milk, then cover with salt. After ten min-
