The souring milk is due to the lactic acid-forming bacteria which are present in milk. These bacteria, be sidese souring milk, are antagonist'c to most of the common bacteria and because of this, sour milk is commonly looked upon as having antiseptic pro perties. The antiseptic values of sour milk is believed by authorities to be the means of prolonging life among the people who use it in appreclable amounts.

Sour milk, like sweet milk, is a wholesome and nutritious food. It can be used in baking in place of sweet milk and usually results in lighter and more tender products. When substitu ting sour for sweet milk these rules have been found practicable:
