Placer locations must conform to the lines of the United States surveys where the land has been surveyed. For this purpose a tract of land may be subdivided into squares containing ten acres each, two of which constitute a single claim or location. A ten acre tract measures 660 feet on either side, making a twenty acre placer claim 660 feet wide and 1320 feet in length. In some districts the local laws reduce the size of a claim to less than this amount but no local laws can make a claim larger than twenty acres.
