## Visited By a '44 Pioneer.

John Cann, a Pacific coast pioneer of 1844, who came across the plains with Kit Carson and Joe Meek, whose names are famous in conjunction with the saying of this north coast to the United States, visited Ashland one day this week en route home to New Mexico from a trip to Portland. He conducted a saloon in Ashland during railroad construction period. He says that with the exception of himself and one other man residing in Idaho, all the members of the Meek and Carson party who came to Oregon in 1844 are dead, and that Meek and Carson are occupying pauper's graves in the Willamette valley and New Mexico, respectively, the very sections that their enterprise, self-sacrifice and bravery saved to the United States. Cann is now 87 years old and his monstrous frame is yet powerful. He was engaged in the Rogue River war in the early fifties, coming from Yreka to take part.—Ashland Record.

## Developing the Ruby Mine.

Albert Collins, of Watkins, was in Jacksonville last Friday for a load of grub and mining supplies for himself and William Hecker to take to their mine, known as the Ruby, on Fall creek, a tributary of Middle Applegate. These young men have a ledge that has proven to be quite rich for they have taken out of it over \$6,000 and now they are going to further open it up with the expectation of finding another big pay chute. The entire ledge, though, carries good values and Messrs. Collins and Hecker expect later on to put in a mill to handle their ore. They now have a tunnel in 125 feet and a shaft down 40 feet and their first work will be to make a connection, after which they will do some extensive development work this fall and winter.

## Candles Made to Order.

A Michigan mining company has their candles made to order and colored a green tint, the color fading not being for aesthetic reasons but to make detection easy in case their candles should be appropriated by private individuals. As the candle expense is an important one to the big mining companies, the candle bills running from \$10,000 to \$20,000 a year to many companies, the Homestake gold mine in the Black Hills, South Dakota, using last year \$19,833 worth of candles, it is a matter of economy to guard against loss in this item of expense.
