ely side of Pine for the length of block 5, and on westerly side of block 94 on Sixth, between Oak and Plum. A petition to secure undedicated portion of Jefferson street between Second and Third and open same for street, was referred to street committee. Street lights were ordered on Second street at the corners of Jefferson, Lincoln and Grant.

A resolution was passed, opposed by Bennett, granting the Klamath Falls Land & Transportation Company the privilege of discontinuing their street car service from the present time until April 15, 1908.

The request of the fire boys was granted for equipment, consisting of twenty-four coats, thirty-six caps, eight pair of blankets, nine pair of overalls, and eight pair of rubber boots, and Chief Oliver was instructed to purchase same.

An ordinance, introduced by Stitts, providing for the regulation and licensing of drays was passed to its second reading.

On motion of Schallcock, the liquor ordinance, previously before the Council, was laid on the table indefinitely. The amount of the license has been left blank and there is a diversity of feeling in regard to raising the license at present.
