SEARS CAMPS CLOSE TO CITY

Contractor Sears has been busy establishing his camps today and will commence work on the roadbed tomorrow. His camps are located about three miles below the city at the end of the embankment thrown up by the Adams dredge. This is near the old Lewis place and can be reached by boat or wagon road. Mr. Sears will use a crew of about sixty men and has over 100 mules on the job. His first work will be on the fill near the camp and the grade will be rushed. It is expected that the road between this city and Midland will be ready for rails within two months and perhaps earlier.
