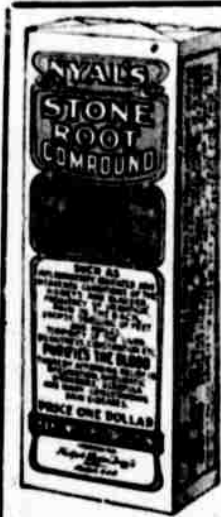

President W. H. Daugherty of the Portland union stockyards, and principal owner of the Henrietta mills and alfalfa meal works at Echo, states that the demand for alfalfa meal is much greater than the capacity of his plant and plans are now under way for the enlargement of the plant. "We are running full time," said Mr. Daugherty, "and we are unable to supply the demand. Because of its greater lowered price and good quality, alfalfa meal is fast taking the place of the more expensive mill-feeds."
