THE SPEAKERSHIP TANGLE.

Aspirants for President of the Senate See Other Honors Attached to Prize.

PORTLAND, Ore.—There is a new element involved in the fight for president of the Senate. It concerns the Governorship of the state of Oregon and adds zest to the attempts of Jay Bowerman, S. C. Beach and Tom Kay to be elected presiding officer of the state Senate.

When George E. Chamberlain is elected United States Senator, Secretary of State Benson will be Acting Governor and also occupy his present position, thus filling two offices and drawing two salaries. In the event of Benson being incapacitated through ill-health, resulting in his resignation, the President of the Senate becomes Acting Governor, and can make an appointment to fill the vacancy of Secretary of State. Should Benson desire to resign, after Chamberlain's election, he cannot, it is said, appoint a Secretary of State, in his capacity as Acting Governor, for he is only Governor through virtue of being elected Secretary of State. Furthermore, in resigning the secretaryship, Benson cuts himself off as Acting Governor, and cannot, consequently, designate his successor. On the other hand, the resignation of Benson makes the President of the Senate Acting Governor, and he would be in a position to select and appoint a new Secretary of State.

Mr. Benson, while at present in good health, was ill last summer and had to go to California. This leads politicians to consider the possibility of Benson resigning before his term of office expires, two years hence. The possibility of becoming Acting Governor has not been overlooked by the aspirants for President, and has, perhaps, whetted their ambition. This condition in politics respecting the Governorship has been talked of for several weeks, and has been considered by a number of the Republican leaders of the state, who have discussed it in many phases.

Concerning the contest for President, however, there have been no changes for a week. Jay Bowerman intends remaining in Portland until the Legislature is ready to organize, and he is trying to secure additions to the pledges he now possesses. Actual pledges are difficult to obtain, and at least one-third of the Republican Senators have refused to commit themselves to any one candidate, although holding out hopes to all. It is on these unsubstantial hopes that aspirants base their strength. Some time next week the Senate organization is expected to become more prominent. The holiday season has interfered with politics to a noticeable degree.

Many changes are predicted in the Speakership tangle next week. Legislators are heading for Portland, and one or two drop in every day to see what is going on. John C. McCue, a candidate for Speaker, is in town, and has been visiting such outside delegates as are in the city, and he has also had a talk with C. N. McArthur, who is one of his rivals. L. E. Bean is expected in Portland next week, as also is James V. Campbell, still another candidate.

One estimate of the strength of these aspirants is given as follows: McArthur, 15; Bean, 15; McCue, 19, and Campbell, 7. McArthur is claiming 22, but while he may have this number friendly to him, McArthur has not shown 22 pledges. McCue has received encouragement in the past few days, which has sent his stock going upward, while Campbell appears to be at a standstill. Bean looks for help from the Multnomah delegation.

The final line-up will be between some two candidates, the others dropping out. The Multnomah delegation, or rather the Statement members of the delegation, will eventually determine which two candidates shall be in the running.

Meanwhile the crowd of seekers for clerkships and desk positions in the Legislature continue to multiply.

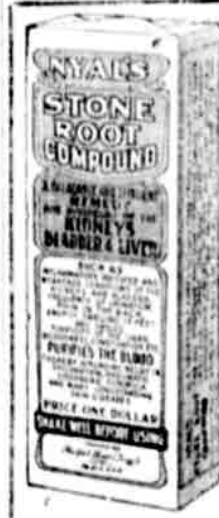
