That the rate of excavation of the Panama Canal is greatly dependent upon the rainfall, is shown by the increase in the amount of material removed in different months. During one month recently, when there was a precipitation of 11.66 inches, the excavation amounted to 2,970,494 cubic yards. In another month, when the total rainfall was 5.93 inches, the total excavation exceeded that of the former month by 243,179 cubic yards and amounted to 3,263,673 cubic yards. This is only 216,597 cubic yards less than the highest record made in March last, when the total was 3,480,270 cubic yards.
