Results of Geological Survey Experiments.

... The Geological Survey experiments... which are set forth by E. B. Phelps... in Water-Supply Paper 225, just... issued, show that the application of... a small amount of available chlorine... in the form of bleaching powder to... the customary "purified" sewage... effects satisfactory disinfection. The... of bacteria by this means averages... over 95 per cent, making the removal... for the whole purification process... to 99 per cent of the number in the... raw sewage. The cost of disinfection... ranges from \$1 to \$1.50 per... million gallons of sewage, depending... chiefly on the size of the plant. Five... parts per million of chlorine... probably represents the maximum amount... required for the treatment of trickling... filter effluents of good quality. The... results obtained do not, of course... amount to complete sterilization... but they may reasonably be... called "practical disinfection." Considerable... additional cost is required to... improve them but slightly. Mr. Phelps... paper may be obtained free of cost... from the Director, United States... Geological Survey, Washington, D. C.
