### The Cookbook.

Sweet pickles, olives, capers and celery chopped very fine make an excellent salad seasoning.

The addition of a few chopped nuts and some candied orange peel is worth while in making mince meat.

Never allow the cake to brown until it has risen to its full height. If it begins to brown while rising put a sheet of paper over the top of it.

The thin membrane that extends from the flank across the intestines of a rabbit should be removed when it is cooked or the strong flavor is very noticeable. Always soak wild game in salt water before cooking.

Apple sauce makes an appetizing dessert if stirred into the beaten whites of egg and stiffened with pulverized sugar. Serve in sherbet glasses with cut up dates on top. A custard sauce is an improvement.

### English Etchings.

A north of England schoolmaster is said to have been giving his pupils a lesson on the use of a pen.

A London newspaper in its April 1 issue printed the following dispatch under a Welsh date line: "A pen are ere all off on ell."

London has long been the leading port of the world. For many years little money has been expended on harbor improvements, but vast sums will soon be used in bettering its facilities.

### College and School.

Corporal punishment is not permitted in the schools of Mexico, and it is forbidden by statute in the state of Chihuahua.

Dr. Frederic de Sola Mendes has been the rabbi for the congregation Shaaray Tefila in New York for thirty-five years. Dr. Mendes is the editor of "The History of the Jews" and revising author of the "Jewish Encyclopedia." He founded the American Hebrew in 1879 and was its editor until 1885.
