## KLAMATH COUNTY HIGH IS ONE.

University Matriculates Graduates Without Examination.

EUGENE, Ore., June 18.—There are forty-six preparatory schools in the State which the University recognizes as accredited high schools, and from which students are accepted upon the recommendation of the principal. Students from other schools in the State must pass satisfactory examinations before entering Oregon University.

Accredited high schools are those which have a four years' course with a nine months' year and subjects running for half a year or more, five times a week with recitations forty minutes long, and which have the courses stipulated in the State High School course.

In the list of accredited schools is the Klamath County High School.

## TELEGRAPH BRIEVITIES.

A strike involving 10,000 men of the iron and steel industry has been ordered at Pittsburgh, to take effect on June 20th.

The Senate Wednesday adopted the free trade provision of the tariff bill relative to Philippine products.

Baker City citizens have pledged themselves to raise a bonus of \$10,000 to secure the extension of the Sanpter Valley railroad into Jay Day valley. Citizens of John Day valley have raised \$2,000 to assist. The Dallas Military Trust Company has pledged \$10,000.

An explosion of a boiler in the Denver Gas and Electric Company killed four men and caused a property damage to the amount of \$25,000.

Governor Hadley of Missouri vetoed a bill providing an expenditure of \$20,000 for a Missouri exhibit at the Seattle fair on the ground that the State had better use for the money to educate its citizens and care for the poor.

The new laws against cigarette smoking and providing for medical examinations to secure marriage licenses in the State of Washington does not appear to stop the one or deter the other, since at Dayton the first law had one violator on Wednesday, when the new laws went into effect, and two marriage licenses were issued.

Suit has been brought in Salem to recover for the sale of bogus United Wireless stock. It is said there are thousands of forged United Wireless stock certificates in Oregon that have been purchased in good faith.

The Senate judiciary committee, with permission of Attorney General Wickersham, examined a report marked "secret" by former Attorney General Bonaparte.

The Grand Lodge of Masons, which met at Portland this week, gives its membership in Oregon as 9,232. The Eastern Star has a total membership in the State of 7,863.

Dayton closed her last two saloons Wednesday night, and the town is now dry.

The opening of the Oregon building at the A-Y-P. exposition took place yesterday, the dedicatory address being made by Governor Benson.
