LEFT SWING TO RIGHT EYE GIVES NEGRO ADVANTAGE

JEFFRIES DAZED BY CHANCE BLOW

Optic Nerve Was so Affected After Second Round That He Saw Double During Fight

RENO, Nev., July 5.—Jack Johnson knocked out James J. Jeffries in the fifteenth round of a fight in which he proved the better man during the whole contest.

Perhaps it was because the youthful stamina was lacking, perhaps of something psychological, perhaps a piece of luck; at any rate, Jack Johnson stands forth the greatest heavyweight pugilist in the world. There is none to dispute his title, unless it is Sam Langford.

Johnson showed the greater speed, strength, judgment and skill.

Jeffries Goes to Pieces.

Jeffries lost everything he showed in his training the moment he entered the ring. Why he should go to pieces the moment he entered the ring is a psychological question, but all his trainers say he did so, and lost all save his grit. Then Johnson's left swing to the right eye in the second round was a lucky punch, because it not only closed the right optic, but paralyzed the sympathetic nerve of Jeff's left eye, and caused Jeff to see double. "I would see two Johnsons swing; one would miss and the other one would hit me," said Jeffries.

It is claimed that from the second round on Jeffries fought only instinctively.
