KEEP JURY'S HEALTH GOOD DELICATE JOB FOR JUDGE

Men Who Have in Their Keeping Fate of Meat Packers Go Month Without Illness, But May Be Kept Together Until May

CHICAGO, Jan. 22.—United States District Judge Carpenter is closely guarding the health of the jury in the trial of the ten Chicago meat packers, charged with criminal violation of the Sherman law. He receives a report every morning from the bailiffs on the physical condition of the jurymen, and gives instructions in regard to their care. The jury has been living at a downtown hotel, under guard, since December 19th, and thus far no member has complained of illness. The trial may last until May, and Judge Carpenter is anxious to avoid having the proceedings halted through illness of any juror. The jury is taken

for a two-mile walk every morning after breakfast.

Taking of testimony began December 21, and only nine witnesses have been heard. In addition to their testimony, eighty voluminous statistical documents have been offered in evidence. At the present rate it is estimated that it will take the government until May 1st to complete its case, as District Attorney Wilkerson still has about seventy witnesses to be called. The defense expects to call 100 or more witnesses and offer a mass of documentary evidence, so that the trial may not be concluded until next August or September.
