STRIKERS CHILDREN WILL MAKE PLEA TO CONGRESS

Wives as Well as Little Ones Form Delegation Shortly to Start for Washington and Appear Before Committee on Rules

WASHINGTON, D. C., Feb. 28.—Wives and children of the Lawrence strikers will come to Washington to plead with congress for federal intervention in the strike. A delegation will start for Washington as soon as arrangements can be made. It will appear before the rules committee of the house.

BIG BUSINESS CONTROL OBJECT OF CUMMINS BILL

Would Have Trade Commission of Three Members to Stop Stock Watering, Pulverize Trusts and Wipe Out Wicked Competition

WASHINGTON, D. C., Feb. 28.—Senator Cummins introduced a bill providing for federal control of big business by means of a trade commission of three members. The commission is to be authorized to stop stock watering, to bust trusts and to eliminate cut-throat competition. The bill is intended to supplement the Sherman anti-trust law. It applies only to corporations of more than \$5,000,000 capital and excludes common carriers.

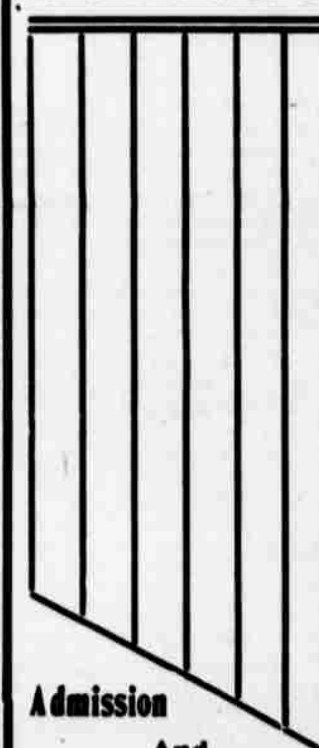

ACCOUNTANT BARRY LANDS NEW JOB, DESPITE THEM

Progressive Republicans Try to Block Him Getting Grand Jury Expert Birth, But Gentleman Proves to Be Too Strong

SACRAMENTO, Feb. 28.—John Barry, former accountant of the state board of control, and ousted by that body, is to be appointed expert of the grand jury of Sacramento county.

WANT HUTTON ELIMINATED IN FIXING DARROW TRIAL

Second Petition Asks for Writ of Mandate to Compel District Attorney's Office to Give Darrow Complete Copy of Evidence.

LOS ANGELES, Feb. 28.—A petition was filed in the appellate court asking that Judge Hutton be prohibited from setting the trial of Clarence Darrow, charged with bribery in connection with the McNamara trial.

Another petition was filed asking a writ of mandate to compel the district attorney's office to give Darrow a complete transcript of the evidence before the grand jury that indicted Darrow. The appellate court will hold a hearing on the petitions March 4th.
