GREEKS WANT DAMAGES FOR BEING SHANGHAIED

Suits for Amounts Aggregating Probably Over Quarter of Million Will Be Entered by Laborers Shipped Out of City by Muscular Mode

SEATTLE, April 5.—Suits for damages aggregating probably more than \$250,000 will be started by 200 striking Greek mill workers, who were shipped out of Raymond, Wash., by "strong-arm" methods last Saturday, against that city. Treaty rights were violated, it is claimed.
