PRISONER WANTS TO HANG RATHER THAN BE SHOT

Condemned Man in Utah Sore on the
State, and Wishes to Make His
Judicial Extinguishment as Ex-
pensive as Possible.

SALEM, April 8.—Deputy Sheriff
Shetter of Utah is visiting at the
State penitentiary here to ascertain
the proper way to construct a scaf-
fold for execution purposes. Accord-
ing to Shetter, there has not been an
execution by hanging in Utah for
seventeen years, the murderers of
that state preferring to be shot, and
the state allowing them this privi-
lege. But recently a condemned man
expressed a desire to be hanged, say-
ing that he was "sore on the state,
and wanted to make the execution as
expensive as possible."

The court granted his request, and
he will be hanged as soon as Shetter
returns with the plans for the scaf-
fold.

SEATTLE, April 8.—Accompanied
by two guards, Dr. Linda Burfield
Hazzard, the "fast" specialist, con-
victed of manslaughter for starving to
death Claire Williamson, a wealthy
English girl, who was taking her
"treatment," took a three-mile walk
today. She has entered upon the sec-
ond third of her thirty-day fast.

"I am anxious, especially from now
on, to have as many people as possi-
ble keep watch over me," said Dr.
Hazzard. "I am now entering the
period of my fast when, according to
some physicians, I should be fast
ebbing away and begin to see death
staring at me. You can see that I am
in excellent spirits, though I have
lost considerable weight."

HUNDRED AEROPLANES IN FRENCH ARMY MANEUVERS

War Minister and Army Chief Agree
Upon Plans Which Calculate Inclusion
of Enough Infantry, Cavalry,
Artillery and Airships for Record

PARIS, April 8.—Over 100 aero-
planes will take part in the annual
maneuvers of the French army this
year, according to plans agreed upon
by Minister of War Millerand and
General Joffre, the army chief. It is
expected that the maneuvers, which
will take place in September in the
Loudun-Chatellerault region, will be
the biggest in history, at least thir-
teen divisions of infantry and caval-
ry, 150 batteries of artillery, over
100 aeroplanes, several dirigibles and
other aircraft taking part.
