COLUMBUS, May 6.—Taft and Bryan are in Ohio to join Harmon, Wilson and Roosevelt in a tour before the primaries May 21st. Taft spoke from the rear platform on his way to Cincinnati. Bryan's tour begins tonight with the Wilsonites directing it, and ends Thursday.

Claim Victory for Teddy

BALTIMORE, May 6.—Early vote at the primaries was large, the weather being fine. Roosevelt managers are claiming a victory, while the men from the Taft camp are reticent. It is not believed the result will be known until tomorrow.

Vote Close in Texas

AUSTIN, Texas, May 6.—Returns of Saturday's precinct conventions indicate that Roosevelt is leading in the instructed vote for the county conventions. Taftites will probably carry the fight to the floor of the national convention. The vote is close everywhere. Wilson's vote is three times that of Clark and Harmon combined.
