## FIRST ELK ARRIVALS TO BE 30,000 STRONG

One Hundred and Thirty Special Trains Will Arrive in Portland on Sunday and Monday, July 7th and 8th, for Elk's Grand Lodge

PORTLAND, May 13.—Estimates made at Elk's Grand Lodge convention headquarters are that fully 130 special trains carrying more than 30,000 delegates and visitors to the reunion in July, will arrive here either Sunday evening, July 7th, or early Monday morning, July 8th.

The Southern Pacific will handle fourteen specials from California alone, as follows: San Francisco 3; Oakland 2, San Jose 1, Sacramento 1, Fresno 1, Berkeley 1, San Diego 1, Los Angeles 2 and the orange belt 1. These will arrive in Portland Monday morning. In addition there will be one special from Klamath Falls and one from Medford. The regular trains will operate in two or three sections, carrying smaller parties, and the extra special trains from Louisiana, Texas and the Southwest will bring the total over the Southern Pacific up to at least 30,000.

The S. W. R. & N. has already been ordered to twenty-two through trains, and with others yet to be heard from the East and from cities in Western Oregon and Washington, the total for this road will run up to forty.

The Northern Pacific has fully twenty specials in sight, the Canadian Pacific fully that many, while the Great Northern and Milwaukee will handle all the way from ten to twenty each.

"I would not be a bit surprised if we had 150 special train loads of Elks here in July," said Secretary McAllister. "We already have in sight a greater number of special trains than ever handled a convention crowd in the history of American railroading."

The problem of handling these trains promptly is one that is already worrying the Northern Pacific Terminal company, and the Elks transportation committee. There is not sufficient yardage and tracks in Portland to provide room for much more than half this number of trains.

Word was received from the Indiana State Elks' Association, consisting of fifty-seven lodges, with a membership of 14,000, that it would send a special train with 550 Elks on board. The Kansas and Missouri State Associations will each have heavily loaded specials.

All three of these organizations held their annual meetings within the next two weeks, and hundreds of pounds of convention literature has been forwarded to their convention headquarters in the last few days. The Elks of Klamath county,

Washington, have organized for the purpose of entertaining Elk visitors as they pass Butler Landing on the Columbia River. A royal chinook salmon and fish food barbecue will be provided for the Elk trains as they pass through.

## ADVISE CHANGE AS TO SCHOOL SYSTEM

SOCIALISTS IN NATIONAL CONVENTION RECOMMEND SOME CHANGES TO MAKE SCHOOL SYSTEM EFFECTIVE

INDIANAPOLIS, May 13.—The committee on education recommended that to make the school system of the country effective the following was necessary:

Approval of national, state and local action leading to the establishment of vocational instruction in the elementary schools. (Vocational includes agricultural, commercial, domestic and professional, as well as industrial. Much of the school work is already vocational for those entering the professions—about 4 per cent of the pupils; no changes are needed in this direction.)

Approval of the establishment of vocational guidance work in cities and towns.

Approval of extension of census work, or the establishment of permanent census work in the direction of yielding information as to the industrial changes and as to the character of the population.

Approval of extension of age compulsory education, with provisions for monetary compensation wherever necessary.

Support of legislation that will prohibit all work for children which does not lead to increasing economic and social worth.

Opposition to arrangements between school (public) officials and shop owners that leave the control of the education in the hands of the employers.

Insistence upon the control of industrial education being in the hands of truly representative bodies.

Insistence upon the subordination in public schools of skill and speed to understanding and appreciation.

Insistence upon emphasis being laid upon citizenship and manhood and womanhood.

Insistence upon administration that will permit of flexible re-adjustment of pupils to their own developing powers on the one hand, and to changing economic conditions on the other.
