

WANTS REPRESENTATION BASED ON POPULATION

The People's Power League Frames a Legislature-Abolishes Senate and the South Umpqua River. Confines House to Sixty Members

PORTLAND, May 20.—Representament Multnomah county, containing miles, state, never has had all the members to which it was entitled. Under the scribed words stating that Myrtle pre-cooling and pre-icing which the proposed measure Multnomah would Creek was the key to the northern California citrus fruit growers startnot have as many members as at senate, and keeps the house of representatives with sixty members. every two years, the measure provides that representatives be elected for a term of four years. The compensation is \$3 a day and \$3 for every twenty miles traveled going to and from the sessions. An honored practice, that of dodg-

ing roll call when a member does not want to go on record for or against a bill receives a body blow in the proposed measure. Every time a member fails to vote on roll call \$10 is deducted from his salary, unless excused by a yea and nay vote of a majority of all the members.
