DAIRYING AND CIVIC IMPROVEMENTS

AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE HOLDS INSTITUTE AT HUXTON—KENT, JUDD AND FLINT AMONG THE SPEAKERS

Special to the Herald CORVALLIS, May 29.—A series of institutes on dairying and civic improvements have been held at Huxton by the extension division of the Oregon Agricultural college. Prof. F. L. Kent of the college dairy school and Deputy Food and Dairy Commissioner E. T. Judd have been in charge of the dairy meetings, and Prof. C. L. Flint, landscape gardener at the college, gave the instruction in methods of planning and planting grounds and parks.
