ELECTRIC CURRENT CAUSE OF DEATH

Although it was found that no person was criminally responsible for the death of Horace G. Cox, a coroner's jury late Thursday afternoon found that the electric lines in this city are not as they should be, and, in the verdict rendered, the recommendation is made that either the city council or the power company take steps to remedy a fault which was responsible in a measure for the death of the young man.

The jury found that the death of young Cox was due to an electric shock, and not to the fall, as it was at first supposed.

An autopsy performed by Drs. Chilton, Morrow and Fisher resulted in the tracing of the electric current through the young man's body, and it was the opinion of the physicians that Cox was dead before he struck the ground.

The verdict of the coroner's jury follows:

"Klamath Falls, Ore., Aug. 22, 1912

"We, the jury empanelled and sworn to inquire into the cause of the death of Horace G. Cox, find that the deceased's name is Horace G. Cox, that he met his death on August 21, 1912, at about the hour of 6 o'clock p. m., that he met his death at the corner of Ninth and Bush streets in the City of Klamath Falls, Klamath county, Oregon; that his death was caused by an electrical shock and that no person is guilty of a crime thereby; but we recommend that some action be taken, either by the city council or the power company toward avoiding in the future the possibility of a similar accident by enforcing the trimming of trees so they do not come in contact with electrical wires upon the public streets of this city.

A Glance at the Sporting Dope

The last of the victorious American athletes to the Olympic games in Stockholm have arrived in New York. Arrangements are about completed for the great demonstration that is to be given the men on Saturday night, when the entire country will be interested in the event.

James Fitzgerald, the Australian runner, made a new world's record when he covered 15 miles in 1 hour 21 minutes 41.15 seconds in a match race with Victor Norman, who quit running in the ninth lap. The former record was 1:22:56, and is held by Fred Appleby of England.

Joe Bayley, Canadian lightweight champion, knocked out Pat Scott of Seattle in the sixth round of a 15-round boxing bout before 2,500 fight fans at the Arena rink in Victoria, B. C. It was a fast contest throughout, Bayley leading in every round. Scott had a look-in in only the second, when he missed a vicious swing which had the right label on it. Ernie Barrieau, champion amateur, and the Doble Kid challenged the winner.
