SALEM, Nov. 16 .- According to an outline prepared by Governor West the following constitutional retrictions on assessment and taxation exist in the state as a result of the reent election:

No tax or duty shall be imposed without the consent of the people or their representatives in the legisla-tive gasembly, Taxos shall be levied for public

urposes only.

The power of taxation shall never

be surrendered, suspended or conrected away.

No poli or head tax shall be levied or collected.

The legislature shall provide by law for uniform and equal rates of of all property, both real and per-sonal, excepting such only for muni-cipal, educational, literary, scientific.

cipal, educational, literary, scientific, religious or charitable purposes, as may be specially exempted by law.

All taxes shall be uniform upon the same class of property within the territorial limits of the authority levyag the tax.
